Pretty Photoshop Actions Bi-annual Scholarship

Amount: Up to \$1000

Deadline: 10/15/2024

Description: Carefully research and compose an essay style Adobe Photoshop tutorial of 800 to 1,000 words, see website for details.

Eligibility: The requirements for eligible student entries are:

- You should presently be a senior in high school;
- Or be transitioning from high school to a college or university;
- Or be already enrolled in a college or university inside the United States or Canada.
- Employees and their immediate family members of Pretty Lightroom Presets and Actions are not eligible to participate.

Amount: \$10,000

Description: Complete online application and complete a personal statement in 250 words or less based on one of the prompts provided.

Eligibility: This is a Scholarship for all Grade Levels that demonstrate forward motion and drive in education.

National Young Arts Foundation Scholarships

Amount: \$Up to \$10,000

Deadline: 10/17/2024

Description: A competition for young (high school) artists. Depending on what category you're applying for, there will be differing rules , so please read the website carefully

Eligibility: Applicant is: either a citizen of the United States, a permanent resident or legally able to receive taxable income in the U.S. (i.e., have a social security number). In grades 10–12 or 15–18 years of age on December 1 of the year they are applying. If selected as an award winner with distinction, this would be their first time attending National YoungArts Week.

Daniels Scholarship

Amount: Varies

Deadline: 10/18/2024

Description: Must be a graduating high school senior who is a resident of CO, NM, UT, or WY and demonstrate financial need.

Eligibility: To be eligible for the Daniels Scholarship Program, students must meet the following requirements at the time of application:

- Be a graduating high school senior
- Be a resident of Colorado, New Mexico, Utah, or Wyoming
- Be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States
- Earn a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0 in high school (on an unweighted 4.0 scale)
- Earn a minimum SAT Math score of 490 and a minimum Evidence-Based Reading & Writing score of 490, or a minimum ACT score of 18 in each category (writing score not required).
- Meet financial eligibility requirements as described on the website.

Society of Illustrators Annual Student Scholarship Show

Amount: Up to \$5,000

Deadline: 10/23/2024

Description: Scholarships are awarded based on a judged art competition. Eligibility: Any illustration initially created or published between October 1st 2023, and November 1st 2024, that has not been entered or accepted in the Annual previously, is eligible. International entries are welcome! Each submission will receive consideration by every member of the jury for its category.

Delete Cyberbullying Beyond School Walls Scholarship

Amount: \$1,000

Eligibility: For students working towards a degree in instrumental (band) music education and attending a college/university in the United States.

Elks Most Valuable Student Competition

Amount: Up to \$30,000

Deadline: 11/12/2024

Description: Applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, and financial need.

Eligibility:

- Current high school seniors, or the equivalent, who are citizens of the United States are eligible to apply.
- Applicants do not need to be related to a member of the Elks.
- High school graduates are not eligible to apply.

- Applicants must be citizens of the United States on the date their applications are submitted; permanent legal resident status does not qualify.

Eligibility: Students must be legal residents of the United States and be enrolled in an accredited college or university in the United States. Students must also have attended an accredited school for at least one full year before applying.

The Department of Education will begin the launch of the **2025-26 FAFSA** as of **December 1st, 2024**. The 2025-26 FAFSA can be accessed at: <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>

What You'll Need To Complete the 2025-26 FAFSA Form:

- StudentAid.gov account (students and contributors must each have their own account)
- Your Social Security number (unless you are a citizen of the Freely Associated States)
- Your 2023 tax records

- Records of your assets including any child support received; current balances of cash, savings and checking accounts; and net worth of investments, businesses, and farms
- Your contributor's information including their name, date of birth, Social Security number (if they have one) and email address
- The list of schools you're applying to (if you're a high school senior) or your current school's name
